#### **THE HAWKS**

- → SJU rallied for a 74-70 win over Richmond on Wednesday. **Jared Bynum** hit the go-ahead free throws at 1.6 seconds and **Charlie Brown** posted 31 points and 14 rebounds as the Hawks fought back from a 15-point deficit
- → Saint Joseph's continues to rank second in the nation in turnovers per game, with an average of 9.4. Freshman **Jared Bynum** tops the A-10 and ranks 33rd in the nation in assist/turnover ratio with 2.9 per game
- → Charlie Brown is the leading scorer in the Atlantic 10, averaging 19.6 ppg
- → Jared Bynum was named the Atlantic 10 Co-Rookie of the Week (more on pg. 3)
- → Due to injuries, the number of available full scholarship players has been reduced to just seven. **Anthony Longpré** is in concussion protocol and doubtful for tonight
- → This is the Hawks' third Big 5 game of the year; they will close out City Series play on Feb. 5 at La Salle
- → **Phil Martelli** and staff will be wearing sneakers for the annual Suits and Sneakers Week, the Coaches vs. Cancer initiative. They will be wearing gold laces in memory of Lace Holsworth, while Martelli will have a special Coaches vs. Cancer tie (more on pg. 3)

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

• Jared Bynum broke a tie with two free throws with 1.6 seconds remaining, and Charlie Brown, Jr., had 31 points and a career-high 14 rebounds, to lead Saint Joseph's to a 74-70 come-from-behind win over Richmond • Taylor Funk connected on a three-pointer with 34.3 seconds left to tie the game at 70-70, and then blocked a shot at the other end with 9.5 left to give the Hawks the ball. Bynum drove the lane and was fouled, and knocked down both ends of the one-andone to give SJU the decisive points. Brown intercepted Richmond's inbound pass at 1.6, was fouled, and converted two free throws to provide the final margin

#### **LAST TIME VS. PENN**

- Saint Joseph's couldn't overcome a strong second half by Penn, losing to the Quakers, 67-56, on Jan. 27, 2018
- Penn scored 12 straight points in the second half to break open a tight game. With SJU leading, 37-35, Penn used a 12-0 run over four minutes to give the Quakers their biggest lead of the game to that point, 47-37
- The Hawks came within 59-53 at 2:25, but that's as close as they would get

#### **PEP RALLY**

- The Hawks fought from a 15-point first-half deficit to rally for the win over Richmond
- It was the largest deficit overcome for a win this season, surpassing the 13 points in the Illinois Chicago game on Nov. 28

#### **CHARLES IN CHARGE**

- Charlie Brown had the game you'd expect from the A-10's leading scorer to key the comeback win over Richmond
- Brown finished with 31 points and a careerhigh 14 rebounds for the first double-double of his career
- In the second half, the redshirt soph connected on 6-of-9 from the field and 3-of-4 from three-point range, finishing the game with five three-pointers
- It was Brown's eighth game with 20 or more points and his second with 30-plus points
- That performance came after Brown scored just nine points at Saint Louis, which was his first time without double figures since Jan. 7, 2017 against Fordam (0 points)

#### **KEY TO THE CITY**

- The Hawks are 0-2 in the Big 5 after losses to Temple and Villanova; SJU went 1-3 in the City Series last year
- Saint Joseph's has won 20 Big 5 titles (9 outright/11 shared), which is behind Temple's 27 titles (6/21 shared) and Villanova's 26 (15 outright/11 shared)

• SJU will close out City Series play on Feb. 5 with the game at La Salle

#### **HOME AWAY FROM HOME**

- Saint Joseph's has utilized The Palestra as an alternate home venue ever since the beginning of the Big 5 in 1955, and owns an all-time record of 336-166 in the building
- The 2018-19 season marks the 64th consecutive season in which Saint Joseph's will play at least one game at The Palestra, which remains an integral part of SJU basketball history
- The Hawks scored one victory here already this season with the 45-42 win over Loyola Chicago on Dec. 22. It's the first season since 2012-13 that SJU is playing more than one game at The Palestra

#### **FOR A GOOD CAUSE**

- It is Suits and Sneakers Week, a Coaches vs. Cancer initiative where the nation's coaches will be wearing sneakers on the sidelines to raise awareness in the fight against cancer. **Phil Martelli** and staff are participating in both games this week

- Martelli will also be wearing a speciallydesigned Coaches vs. Cancer tie, courtesy of Vineyard Vines
- Martelli is passionate for his work with Coaches vs. Cancer. He is the co-chair of the Philadelphia Coaches vs. Cancer effort, which is one of the nation's highest fundraising groups; comprised of the city's six Division I coaches and their wives, the group has raised over \$14 million

#### **MID-SEASON GRIND**

- The Hawks finally got two days off last weekend after finishing a stretch of 18 straight days with games or practices. They had six games from Jan. 1 to 18
- SJU is now in the midst of nine days without a break (Jan. 21-29), including three games

#### THE INJURY PLAGUE

- Saint Joseph's has certainly faced its share of significant injuries in three consecutive years, and now with the current injuries to **Pierfrancesco Oliva** and **Lamarr Kimble**
- Oliva will miss the rest of the season and Kimble is sidelined indefinitely as both sustained injuries in the Hawks' loss at Duquesne
- Oliva, a redshirt junior forward, dislocated his left knee in the first half of the game and has ligament damage. He will require surgery but his rehabilitation timetable is unspecified

- Kimble, a redshirt junior guard, suffered a fracture in his right hand in the second half
- Anthony Longpré, is currently in concussion protocol after being injured at Saint Louis. He is expected to miss his second game tonight
- In 2017-18, Kimble (foot) and **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, (wrist) were lost for the year. Kimble played in only the season opener and Brown was sidelined in the preseason
- The 2016-17 season saw four players miss time with injuries - Shavar Newkirk (19 gms), Oliva (entire season), **Lorenzo Edwards** (all but one game) and Kimble (7 gms)

#### ON THE REBOUND

- SJU had a dominating effort on the boards against Richmond, outrebounding the Spiders, 44-23
- It marked the team's season-high in total rebounds while Charlie Brown and Chris Clover each recorded personal bests with 14 and 10, respectively

#### **OUT OF THE FUNK**

- **Taylor Funk** came up with big plays against Richmond as he hit the tying three-pointer with 34.3 seconds to go. The sophomore also blocked a UR shot with 9.5 seconds left
- Funk connected on 4-of-9 three-pointers in the game, the most since he had four against UIC on Nov. 28
- He has struggled as of late, and in the six games prior to Richmond was a combined 5for-35 from three-point range

#### **CLOVER IN THE CLUTCH**

- Senior **Chris Clover** had his best game of the year when the Hawks needed it, helping the win over Davidson
- Starting in place of the injured **Lamarr Kimble**, Clover scored a season-high 18 points while hitting a personal best four three-pointers, including the eventual game winner with 59 seconds to play
- Clover had a career-high 10 rebounds in the win over Richmond

#### **LODGE IN THE LINEUP**

- Markell Lodge made his first start of the year, and the first since he started all 31 games in 2016-17, when he filled in for **Anthony Longpré** vs. Richmond
- Lodge had seven points and four rebounds in 22 minutes against the Spiders

#### **BYNUM'S WEEK**

- **Jared Bynum** was named the A-10 Co-Rookie of the Week for Jan. 21, earning weekly honors for the second time this year
- The freshman averaged 15.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 8.5 assists per game against Davidson and Saint Louis

#### **NEXT MAN UP**

- With the Hawks facing the absence of two key players, **Phil Martelli** didn't buy into the "next man up" theory, but it certainly seemed like the players did against Davidson
- Senior **Chris Clover** started in place of **Lamarr Kimble** and had his best game of the year with a season-high 18 points
- Graduate transfer **Troy Holston** had his first double-figure game with the Hawks, contributing 11 points, with three three-pointers, in a season-high 21 minutes
- Redshirt senior **Markell Lodge** tied his thenseason-high in minutes (19) and contributed great energy while grabbing five rebounds and blocking two shots

#### **IRON MEN**

- Backcourt mates Lamarr Kimble and Jared Bynum have racked up the minutes
- Prior to his injury, Kimble was averaging 35.8 to rank seventh in the A-10 and 52nd in the NCAA stats
- Bynum is eighth in the A-10 at 35.3 minutes per game, but that number is sure to increase with Kimble sidelined. The freshman has played 40 minutes in the three consecutive games and is now averaging a team-high 37.1 in Atlantic 10 play, to rank sixth in the league

#### ON AND OFF SCORING

- After scoring 60 points or less in six straight games, the Hawks' offense got back to normal and tallied 84 in the loss at Duquesne
- But they slipped back into sub-70 mode vs. Davidson (61) and Saint Louis (57), giving them less than 62 points in eight straight games
- SJU is averaging 62.7 ppg in A-10 games, and has been outscored by 10.3 points. The Hawks are shooting 36.8 percent from the field and 28.1 percent from three-point range in league contests

#### **BYTES ON BYNUM**

- Jared Bynum has been impressive in his first year and is averaging 11.7 points and leading the team in assists with 4.3
- Phil Martelli said, "He might be a freshman academically and socially, but he's a basketball player. He belongs in these games."
- Bynum, who has scored double figures 12 times, had a career-high eight assists at Duquesne and bettered that with nine assists vs. Davidson
- He had a team-high 18 points, as well as six rebounds and eight assists, at Saint Louis
- He's also the A-10's leader in assist/turnover ratio with 2.7 as he averages 4.3 assists to 1.6 turnovers

- A 23-0 run by the home team doomed the Hawks at Saint Louis. SJU was within 36-35 at 13:05 but then the Billikens scored 23 straight points over six minutes to take a 56-35 lead. **Taylor Funk** ended the drought for the Hawks on a three-pointer with 6:38 left, but it was too much for SJU to overcome in the 68-57 loss
- The Hawks appeared to be suffering the same fate vs. Richmond as the Spiders ran off 16 straight points in the first half, staking a 21-10 lead and then a 30-15 edge. SJU turned things around in the second half to post the 74-70 win

#### **SLOW START**

• SJU's 0-4 start in the A-10 matched the 2010-11 season when the Hawks went 0-8 to begin conference play. That team won four of its last six as it reached the semifinals of the A-10 Championship

#### TO THE POINT

- After scoring 70-plus points in eight of their first nine games, the Hawks averaged just 54.2 in six games from Dec. 8 to Jan. 9
- The low was 45 points vs. Loyola Chicago but thankfully, the Ramblers scored only 16 points in the first half and finished with 42 in the game, as SJU came away with the win
- The 45 points was SJU's lowest output since it scored 40 against Charlotte (3/9/13)
- · Other notable scoring droughts:
- SJU scored 59 points vs. Wagner; went without a FG in the final 4:53 of the game
- George Mason had a 19-0 run in six minutes during the final 10 minutes of the game
- GW closed out the game w/ 13 straight and a 16-4 run in the final five minutes
- St. Bonaventure took a 17-1 lead and had a 39-12 halftime lead

#### **TAKING CARE OF THE BALL**

- SJU ranks second in the nation in turnovers per game (9.4) and second in fewest number of turnovers (182); Virginia is the NCAA's leader with 8.7
- Despite a season-high 14 turnovers, the Hawks came away with a win over Richmond
- The Hawks have committed 10-plus turnovers nine times this season, and in eight of the last 10 games
- Freshman **Jared Bynum** leads the A-10 in assist/turnover ratio with 2.7 and is ranked 33rd in the nation. He has 81 assists this year to just 30 turnovers
- Bynum notched eight assists at Duquesne, with just one turnover, and followed that with nine assists vs. Davidson

#### **RECOGNIZING HARD WORK**

- Phil Martelli announced that walk-ons Mike Muggeo and Toliver Freeman have both been awarded scholarships for the Spring semester
- Muggeo, a 6-3 senior guard, earned a spot on the squad as a walk-on in 2017-18, but was unavailable to play last year due to an injury
- Freeman is a 6-3 guard from Baton Rouge, La. (Catholic HS) who joined the Hawks as a walkon in 2016-17. He has seen action in 10 games during his career, including four this season

#### **DOUBLING DOWN**

- Charlie Brown has scored double figures in 17 of 19 games this year, while Lamarr Kimble has hit double digits in 14
- Brown missed one game (Villanova) due to injury, but he saw his 33-game double-figure scoring streak come to an end when he scored nine points at Saint Louis
- Kimble went without double figures against UCF and GW

#### **HANDS OFF**

- As they have done the past few seasons, the Hawks have limited their fouls and rank 10th in the nation with fewest fouls (265)
- SJU ranks eighth in the NCAA in personal fouls per game with 14.7

#### TWO SIDES OF THE BALL

- Early on, **Phil Martelli** had been concerned about the Hawks' defense, as SJU was giving up 76.8 points per game through the first nine contests
- That seemed to be rectified as the Hawks allowed an average of 56 points in the three games (Villanova, Loyola, Wagner) leading up to the conference opener
- But that progress suffered a setback as Saint Joseph's saw George Mason score 85 points
- On the year, SJU's foes are now averaging 72.2 points per game

#### **COOLING OFF**

- The Hawks started the season as one of the better three-point shooting teams in the nation but have since cooled off
- SJU has made under 30 percent of its threepoint attempts in seven of the last 12 games
- The Hawks are converting 72-of-258 (27.9 percent) from behind the arc in the past eight games. The low point was a 0-for-13 effort in the first half at St. Bonaventure while SJU shot 6-for-30 at Saint Louis
- Saint Joseph's bucked that trend when it connected on 12-of-28 threes (42.9%) in the win over Richmond, led by a 5-for-8 effort from **Charlie Brown**

#### **SLIPPING AWAY**

- The loss to GW marked the third double-digit lead lost by the Hawks this year
- SJU had a 12-point lead with 12:41 to go in the first half but saw GW turn in a big second half en route to the 70-56 win
- Against Temple they led by 11 with 3:29 to play in the first half but suffered the 77-70 loss
- At William & Mary, SJU held a 20-point lead at 18:38 of the second half but saw the Tribe rally to the 87-85 win

#### **DEAN OF COACHES**

- **Phil Martelli** is in his 24th season as head coach and is the dean of the Atlantic 10's coaches. He owns an overall record of 439-319 and is SJU's all-time leader in victories
- Martelli owns a 214-169 record in Atlantic 10 play, which ranks second all-time and first among active coaches for conference wins
- His career total of 439 wins is also second alltime (to Temple's John Chaney) and the top number for active coaches in the A-10
- Martelli is one of 25 active D-1 coaches who are their schools' all-time wins leaders

#### A SELECT GROUP

**Phil Martelli** is a member of a select group, as one of eight active D-1 head coaches who have 400+ wins and have only coached at one school. Here's the list:

#### **FRESH APPROACH**

- Lamarr "Fresh" Kimble helped the Hawks pull away at Princeton as he poured in 22 second-half points
- The captain made 8-of-12 from the field in the half, and had 10 of 13 points as SJU expanded on a three-point halftime lead, going up by 53-45
- It was the second game in which Kimble had a big second half to help the Hawks to the win; he previously scored 24 of his career-hightying 31 points vs. UIC in the second half
- Prior to his injury, Kimble was averaging a career-best 16.3 points per game, and has scored 20-plus points in four games

#### WHAT BROWN CAN DO FOR YOU

- Charlie Brown, Jr., established a new careerhigh for the third time this year when he poured in 37 points at William & Mary
- He scored 23 in the first half, the highest single-half total of his career, hitting 11-of-17 from the field and 11-of-14 from the foul line
- His 37 points are tied as the seventh highest single-game scoring total in SJU history
- Brown is the leading scorer in the A-10 with his 19.6 average
- The last Hawk to average 20-plus points in a full season was Jameer Nelson (20.6) in 2003-04. Shavar Newkirk averaged 20.3 ppg in 2016-17, but he played only 12 games after being sidelined an injury

#### THE CAPTAIN, THE HERO

- Lamarr Kimble hit the game-winner with 0.4 left on the clock to lift Saint Joseph's to a 45-42 win over Loyola Chicago at The Palestra
- It was the team captain's third game-winning shot as a Hawk
- "It wasn't exactly the way we drew it up," said coach **Phil Martelli**. "But he's got a little bit of freedom, because his heart's bigger than his body."

#### **THREES ALL AROUND**

- Charlie Brown, Jr., ranks second in the A-10 in three-point percentage (42.2) and is third in threes made per game (2.4)
- Saint Joseph's is fifth in the A-10 in team 3-point percentage, hitting 33.0 percent, but is 14th in league games, making 28.1 percent of its long-range shots

#### **ALL ABOUT ANTHONY**

- Anthony Longpré connected on three three-pointers for a season-high 10 points against George Mason
- He followed that a career-high 11 rebounds, to go along with eight points, vs. GW, and had a team-high six rebounds at St. Bonaventure
- Longpré had another strong game on the boards at Duquesne, leading the squad with nine to go along with nine points

#### **TAYLOR'S THREE'S**

- Sophomore **Taylor Funk** has 120 threepointers in the 51 games of his career thus far, and reached 100 quicker than any other Hawk. By comparison, all-time leader Langston Galloway made 75 threes in his first 37 games
- Funk set the SJU freshman record last season when he made 84 in 32 games
- He hit a career-best 6-for-7 from beyond the arc in the win over Wake Forest

#### LIFT FROM LODGE

- Markell Lodge gave the Hawks a lift at Princeton, recording season-highs of nine points and 14 minutes
- Lodge had three dunks in the game, including one to start a 5-0 run with under six minutes to play, which helped seal the win
- He followed that with 13 minutes at Villanova in which he contributed five points
- Lodge had a season-high three blocks in the Loyola win and matched that with three against George Mason
- He has 10 blocks in A-10 contests to rank sixth in the league

#### 20/20

• **Charlie Brown, Jr.** has tallied 20-plus points in eight of 17 games this season; he has reached 20-plus points nine times in 49 career games

#### **ON BOARD**

- **Taylor Funk** now leads the Hawks in rebounding with 6.1 in overall games and 6.9 in A-10 games. **Charlie Brown** is averaging 5.9 in league contests
- **Pierfrancesco Oliva** had been the Hawks' top rebounder for the first part of the season as he had double-figure rebounds four times

#### **DEPTH CHARGES**

- The Hawks have not gotten much scoring from their bench this season and it has been a contributing factor to nine of the 10 losses, as SJU's reserves have been outscored, 242-65, in those games.
- Here's the bench scoring breakdown:

  - Temple 24, SJU 7
  - West Virginia 46, SJU 6
  - UCF 23, SJU 1

- In the win over Princeton, the teams were tied in bench scoring, 20-20, and in the Loyola Chicago win, the SJU held a 9-6 edge
- The Hawks were on the short end of bench scoring against Wagner, 23-11, but still captured the victory
- The Hawks' reserves held a slight edge, 11-10, at St. Bonaventure in the loss
- SJU outscored Davidson's bench, 15-7, in the victory

#### **SHARP SHOOTERS**

- The Hawks have shot 50 percent or better in 10 of 36 halves played this year, with a high of 58.6 percent in the second half of the Monmouth win
- SJU converted more than 50 percent in both halves at Princeton, making 55.0 percent in the game

#### **PRODUCTIVE 20 MINUTES**

- Lamarr Kimble's 22-point second half at Princeton was his second 20-plus point half of the year, and the third highest of the season
- Kimble had 24 points in the second half against UIC which is highest single-half total for a Hawk this season. Charlie Brown scored 23 of his 37 points vs. William & Mary in the first half
- More recently, Brown scored 23 in the second half to finish with 31 in the win over Richmond

#### **END TO END**

• The win at Princeton was the only game this season that the Hawks held the lead from start to finish. There were two ties, but SJU never let the Tigers forge ahead

#### 30 FOR 30

- SJU received individual 30-point efforts in three consecutive games, as **Lamarr Kimble** netted 31 vs. West Virginia and UIC while **Charlie Brown, Jr.**, had at 37 points at William & Mary
- Brown added another to the list when he scored 31 against Richmond

#### **CHECK IT OUT**

- The Hawks are missing the rebounding and passing ability of **Pierfrancesco "Checco" Oliva**, who was the team's top rebounder before his season-ending injury
- **Phil Martelli** said that although he doesn't like labels, "Oliva is the epitome of a point-forward"

#### **CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN**

- Redshirt junior **Lamarr "Fresh" Kimble** was voted team captain for the third consecutive season, becoming the only player in SJU history to serve as captain for three years
- As a sophomore, Kimble became just the third player in Hawk history to be named a captain in his second season
- Kimble's leadership is appreciated by **Phil Martelli**: "I'm glad he's on my team and I'm glad he's in my program because whatever I need...He's in charge of that locker room... Fresh is just legit. He's one of those guys that embraces being a Philadelphian and playing in Philadelphia....I'm a big Fresh fan, forget the basketball. He is the epitome of a captain."

#### **LOOK AT LORENZO**

- **Phil Martelli** stated in the preseason that redshirt sophomore **Lorenzo Edwards** was one player who had made the biggest strides over the summer
- Edwards gave a glimpse of that improvement as he scored 11 points in 15 minutes vs. Monmouth, making 5-of-7 from the field
- He has seen action in 15 games this year and is averaging 9.8 minutes
- Edwards notched a career-high four blocks against George Mason
- He missed three games with a shoulder injury but returned to action at Saint Louis
- Edwards turned in a strong effort vs. Richmond with seven rebounds and two blocks

#### **SITTING AND WAITING**

- Junior transfer **Ryan Daly** is sitting out the year after transferring from Delaware, and will have two years with the Hawks
- A native of nearby Ardmore, Pa., Daly scored 1,000 points in two seasons at Delaware and earned All-CAA honors twice
- SJU connections run in his family as both of his parents are alums and his late grandfather, Jim Boyle, was the Hawks' head coach from 1981 to 1990. His first cousin is Thomas Boyle, the Hawks' director of operations

#### **SEEING RED**

- SJU's roster is dotted with five players who have redshirted at least one season while on Hawk Hill. Although that number seems unusually high, it is actually tied for the fifth most in the nation. Four schools (CSU Bakersfield, Rider, UCF, Saint Mary's) lead with nine each while four schools have eight redshirts on their active rosters
- Saint Joseph's redshirts are:
- **Charlie Brown, Jr.** (R-So.) missed the 2017-18 season with shoulder injury
- **Lorenzo Edwards** (R-So.) had shoulder surgery during this freshman year
- Lamarr Kimble (R-Jr.) reinjured his foot in the first game of 2017-18 and underwent surgery, missing all but one game
- Markell Lodge (R-Sr.) redshirted his first year to concentrate on academics
- **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (R-Jr.) sat out his sophomore season after having surgery to correct a chronic knee condition

#### FROM THE START

- **Jared Bynum** became the sixth freshman in six years to be in the Hawks' starting lineup on opening day
- Previous freshman starters for SJU were: **Anthony Longpré** (2017-18), **Charlie Brown** (2016-17), **Pierfrancesco Oliva** (2015-16), James Demery (2014-15) and current Atlanta Hawk DeAndre' Bembry (2013-14)

#### **WISE BEYOND THEIR YEARS**

- **Phil Martelli** commented that the Hawks are an "older" team this year with five players who have redshirted previous seasons and one graduate student (**Troy Holston**)
- The average age of the Hawks' scholarship players is 21 years old
- Markell Lodge and Holston are both 23, while Pierfrancesco Oliva and Lamarr Kimble are each 22 years old
- The following are the Hawks' "redshirts" with their respective seasons on campus:
  - Markell Lodge (5th)
  - Pierfrancesco Oliva (4th)
  - Lamarr Kimble (4th)
  - Lorenzo Edwards (3rd)
  - Charlie Brown (3rd)

• Holston is in his first season at SJU after transferring from South Florida. He played two seasons with the Bulls while battling knee injuries

#### **PICKING THE HAWKS**

- Saint Joseph's was picked second in the A-10 Preseason Poll, which is the highest for the Hawks since 2012-13, when they were first
- Last year's squad was picked third in the poll, and despite two key injuries, finished fourth in the league and reached the semifinals while posting a 16-16 overall record
- Lamarr Kimble and Charlie Brown, Jr., were each named to the 2018-19 Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Conference Third Team

#### **STRONG FINISH**

- Despite facing its second straight season with key injuries in 2017-18, the Hawks came on strong at the end of the year and finished with a 16-16 record
- SJU closed out the regular season winning three straight and six of its last seven to finish in fourth place with a 10-8 record
- The Hawks defeated George Mason in the A-10 Quarterfinals but were edged by top-seeded Rhode Island, 90-87, in the semifinals

#### **HONORING THE COACH**

- The Hawks are wearing a patch on their uniforms with "McK" to honor former coach Jack McKinney, who passed away in September
- McKinney was head coach at Saint Joseph's for eight seasons, from 1966 to 1974. He compiled a 144-77 record and owns the third best all-time winning percentage (65.2 pct) among SJU coaches
- McKinney took the Hawks to postseason play five times in his eight years, which included four NCAA Tournament appearances
- He went on to coach in the NBA, although a serious accident cut short his season with the Lakers in 1979. He rebounded to earn NBA Coach of the Year honors with the Indiana Pacers in 1981

#### **FUTURE HAWKS**

- Saint Joseph's signed two standouts to national letters of intent during the early signing period – Hakim Hart and Kenan Sarvan
- Hart, a 6-5, 190-pound, swingman from Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia, averaged 15.1 points per game last season and earned All-Catholic League honors. He helped Roman win the 2018 Philadelphia Catholic League championship and the 2018 PIAA 6A State Championship
- Sarvan is a 6-9, 220-pound forward originally from Holland and currently attending Bishop Sullivan Catholic High School in Virginia Beach. As a junior, he averaged 14.6 points and 7.8 rebounds for the Crusaders

## PHIL MARTELLI Head Coach 24th Season - 439-319

With the 2018-19 season marking his 24th as the head basketball coach at Saint Joseph's, **Phil Martelli** has built a program that is consistently one of the top in the conference, a perennial postseason participant and a key player on the national scene. In doing so, he has earned his place among the top coach-

es in the school's storied history and is one of the more respected coaches in the game.

Martelli is the Hawks' all-time leader in career victories with a mark of 439-319. Setting the school record for wins in a season (30) in 2004, Martelli has guided SJU to 20 or more victories nine times in his 23 previous seasons, which is the most for any Hawks' coach. His record of 214-169 in Atlantic 10 play is the most conference wins for any active coach and ranks second all-time in the league.

#### Martelli Highlights:

- He has taken SJU to the postseason in four of the last seven years, and 13 times in the 23 seasons previous to this one, while winning three Atlantic 10 Championships (1997, 2014, 2016)
- Martelli's 18 postseason wins (7 NCAA, 11 NIT) are the most in school history
- Despite injuries to two key players, his 2017-18 squad won seven of its last nine games, to finish fourth in the Atlantic 10 and reach the conference semifinals
- His 2015-16 team compiled a 28-8 record for the second-most victories for a Hawk team, won its second Atlantic 10 title in three seasons and advanced to the NCAA Second Round for the first time since 2004
- Four of his players have been named the Atlantic 10 Player of the Year, with the most recent being DeAndre' Bembry in 2015-16
- In 2013-14, his veteran team turned in one of the more memorable seasons in school history, adding another A-10 Championship to his résumé as SJU went 24-10 and reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time under Martelli, falling to eventual national champion Connecticut in overtime
- Seven players have reached the NBA, including first round draft picks DeAndre' Bembry (2016), Jameer Nelson (2004) and Delonte West (2004) and a second-round selection, Ahmad Nivins (2009). Dwayne Jones and Ronald Roberts, Jr. had NBA stints while undrafted free agent Langston Galloway earned All-Rookie Second Team honors with the New York Knicks in 2015. Galloway (Detroit) and Bembry (Atlanta) are currently playing in the NBA
- In 2003-04, he guided a squad that became the most compelling story in college basketball the Hawks went undefeated in the regular season, were the top-ranked team in the nation and earned the school's first-ever number-one seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Elite Eight
- Joined with Jameer Nelson to sweep the National Coach and Player of the Year awards in 2004, marking one
  of the few times in history that the top player and coach were from the same school
- Current member of the NCAA Division I Basketball Oversight Committee; previously served the game as a Past President of the NABC's Board of Directors, and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition
- Is very involved with Coaches vs. Cancer, is the past chair of the National Council, and the co-chair of the Philadelphia chapter, which is one of the largest fundraising groups in this effort in the nation
- Was the co-recipient of the Circle of Honor Award given by the American Cancer Society in 2017, honored along with Temple's Fran Dunphy
- Has spent a total of 34 years with the Hawks' program, serving as an assistant coach for 10 years prior to attaining the top job in July, 1995

#### THE HAWK

One of the most famous mascots in college sports, the Saint Joseph's Hawk is in its 63rd year in 2018-19.

The Hawk is best known for staying in constant motion by flapping its wings throughout every basketball game and representing the Saint Joseph's motto, "The Hawk Will Never Die."

The idea for the Hawk as a mascot was originated by Jim Brennan during the 1954-55 season. Brennan, an ex-Marine and SJU cheerleader, at first wanted to secure an actual hawk, but later switched to the costume idea. The stu-



dent government raised the 120 dollars needed to buy the initial costume, which Brennan donned for three years. He made his debut as the Hawk on January 4, 1956, a 69-56 win over La Salle at the Palestra. The Hawk has not missed a men's basketball game since that first season.

In addition to the constant flapping, the Hawk is also recognized by its "flying" in figure eights around the court during timeouts. The constant motion, coupled with the scrappy play of the University's athletic teams, helped to spawn the school's familiar slogan "The Hawk Will Never Die!" A few years ago, ESPN used a "flap-o-meter" on the national telecast of a Saint Joseph's game to estimate that the Hawk flaps its wings 3,500 times during a regulation game.

The Hawk is unique because it is one of the few mascots in the nation that travels to every game, and the student who holds the position gains a tuition scholarship. The student, who is selected through an interview process during the previous spring semester, also serves as a team manager for the men's basketball team and travels with the squad.

**Domenic Godshall** is serving as the Saint Joseph's University Hawk mascot for the 2018-19 season, becoming the 39th student to represent the University in this role. He is a senior sports marketing major from Lititz, Pa.

#### **ON THE AIR**

**TV/VIDEO:** Saint Joseph's fans will be able to watch all 31 men's basketball regular-season games either on television or through digital media. A total of 21 Hawks' games this season will be televised nationally while 10 will be streamed digitally. Nine games will appear on the subscription-based ESPN+.

**RADIO:** All 31 Saint Joseph's men's basketball regular-season games will be broadcast on radio, with Talk Radio 1210 WPHT airing the majority of games. It marks the second consecutive year of a partnership with the station. The Saint Joseph's Sports Network team of Matt Martucci and Lunardi will return for their 10th season together, with Lunardi marking his 29th year as the Hawks' color analyst. Also calling play-by-play on selected games for the second straight year is Pat McCarthy. (Schedule on pg. 2)

**INTERNET:** Information for Saint Joseph's basketball is found at SJU's athletics website, **www.SJUHawks.com** with statistics, updated game notes, and live in-game statistics for all Hawk home games, and selected road games. Through Hawks All-Access, fans can follow every home game through audio streaming, along with video features and highlights.

**PHIL MARTELLI'S HAWKTALK RADIO SHOW:** Phil Martelli's "HawkTalk" Radio Show takes place on Monday's from 7 to 8 p.m. beginning on January 7, and through March 11 (exception Jan. 28) with the broadcast live from JD McGillicuddy's in Havertown, Pa. Live streaming audio is on SJUHawks.com while the show will also be podcast on Talk Radio 1210's website for listening anytime.
