

Phil Martelli put one of his youngest squads in years on the floor in 2006-07 and although the team was inconsistent at times, it gave Hawk fans optimism for the coming years. SJU experienced a rollercoaster ride that included two four-game winning streaks and a late-season three-game losing streak to finish 18-14. Despite the 18 wins, the Hawks saw a streak of six consecutive postseason appearances come to an end.


Among the bright spots was the emergence of Ahmad Nivins and Pat Calathes, who were clearly two of the Atlantic 10's most improved players. Nivins had a breakout year, averaging 16.6 points and 7.6 rebounds and setting the school record for field goal percentage (.631) while earning A-10 All-Conference First Team honors. Calathes was second on the team with 13.9 points and 7.1 rebounds while getting a nod to the All-Conference Third Team.

With a freshman starting backcourt (Jawan Carter, Garrett Williamson), the Hawks opened with three straight wins, and won five of their first seven games. SJU had three games in three days at Louisville's NABC Classic, and despite opening with a win over Bellarmine as Nivins scored a career-high 28 points, SJU lost to the host Cardinals and then Ohio. SJU returned home to post a win over Saint Mary's before the holidays, despite playing without Nivins (sprained ankle).

A rematch with Hofstra (which defeated the Hawks in the 2006 NIT) took place in the Aeropostale Holiday Festival at one of SJU's favorite arenas, Madison Square Garden. The contest turned out to be a highly-competitive game for the early season, and Hofstra handed the Hawks more heartbreak at MSG, winning 65-63 on a shot with 2.2 seconds to play. SJU bounced back to defeat Boston University for the second time and started a four-game winning streak.

The Hawks opened conference play by routing Duquesne at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse behind a career-high 22 points from Rob Ferguson and followed that with road wins at Charlotte and Temple. Nivins had 20 points versus Temple, as the Hawks defeated their city rival for the ninth time in 10 tries.

The streak came to an end with a rare home loss to Rhode Island, 86-81, despite personal best efforts from Nivins (28 pts-11 rebs) and Calathes (20 pts-11 rebs). Fordham would hand the Hawks a 56-55 loss

in the only overtime contest of the season.

SJU bounced back with an exciting 82-74 win over defending A-10 champion Xavier, led by Carter's career-high 20 points. The Hawks seemed to carry that momentum into the first half at George Washington, outscoring GW 20-7 at the start. Despite leading most of the game, the Hawks went cold when it counted and saw GW rally for the 74-65 decision.

Calathes bettered his career-high with 23 points in the 84-74 win over Penn in the soldout Palestra. That was followed by another home loss to Saint Louis and then a win over Dayton, 71-65, on Super Bowl Sunday. The win was significant as it was Martelli's 235th, and moved him into second place on the

Hawks' all-time victory list past legendary coach Jack Ramsay.

The Hawks suffered a huge letdown in the always-anticipated rivalry game with Villanova, scoring a season low in the 56-39 loss at The Pavilion. That low point seemed to serve as a catalyst for the Hawks to play their best basketball of the season, and go on to win four in a row. SJU routed La Salle, 72-50, and then defeated GW, 62-56, as Calathes set the school record for consecutive free throws by hitting his 38th in a row. After a win at St. Bonaventure, the Hawks dominated Temple at the Palestra, 92-76, in one of its best offensive performances of the year.

On the verge of achieving a bye for the Atlantic 10 Tournament, the Hawks had a lackluster effort and were upset by Richmond, 78-68. That started a three-game skid that included losses to Xavier and UMass to push the Hawks into sixth place in the conference, and a first-round game in the tournament.

SJU defeated Temple for the third time in the A-10 First Round as Carter hit the go-ahead free throws. The Hawks' season came to an end in the quarterfinals with the 58-48 loss to GW.

Nivins and Calathes put up career-best numbers with averages of 16.6 and 13.9 points per game, respectively. Nivins led the squad in rebounding with 7.1 per game, while setting the school record for field goal percentage in a season (.631). Calathes also grabbed a personal best 7.1 rebounds per game and topped the Hawks in assists, with 116.



Garrett Williamson's defensive presence helped key a comeback victory over Temple in the Atlantic 10 First Round.

SJU 63- Fairfield 47: The Hawks won their season opener for the second year in a row, defeating Fairfield, 63-47, at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse. **Ahmad Nivins** scored a career-high 20 points, with 15 of them coming in the second half as the Hawks maintained a double-digit lead through the final 20 minutes. **Rob Ferguson** added 14 points as the Hawks(put their new inside game into play. **Pat Calathes** scored 13 and grabbed a career-high nine rebounds as the Hawks shot 58.8 percent in the second half alone. The game was turnover-ridden as SJU committed 22 while Fairfield had 16.

SJU 81- Lafayette 73: Solid shooting and a balanced scoring attack helped the Hawks to an 81-73 win at Lafayette. SJU went 27-of-49 from the floor (55.1 percent) and had five players in double figures. **Rob Ferguson** and **Ahmad Nivins** led the way for the Hawks, scoring 19 points apiece, with freshman **Jawan Carter** hitting for a personal-best 18. SJU would enter halftime up 44-32 despite the Leopards hitting 62 percent of their shots. In the second half, Saint Joseph's quickly opened an 18-point lead. The Hawks committed 16 turnovers in the second half and allowed Lafayette to fight back to within five, 78-73, at :28. But SJU hung on as **Pat Calathes** converted three free throws to seal the win, finishing with 10 points and tied a career-high with nine rebounds.

SJU 63- Bucknell 53: SJU put together an impressive 63-53 win over Bucknell at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse, to end a two-game losing streak against the Bison. The Hawks trailed in the early going, 18-12, but then turned up the intensity on defense, forcing three straight Bison turnovers and tying the game, 21-21, with 5:49 to play. **Pat Calathes** then hit a 3-pointer to give the Hawks a lead they would never relinquish. That started a 13-1 Hawk run, which included seven points from Nivins, that gave SJU a 34-22 lead with under two minutes left in the half. **Ahmad Nivins** had 15 points and nine rebounds, Calathes scored 14, and **Rob Ferguson** had 11 points.

Penn State 65- SJU 61: Penn State erased an eight-point SJU lead with a minute to play to earn the 65-61 win in University Park, Pa. A 3-pointer banked in by PSU's Danny Morrissey with :25 to play was the game winner. Trailing 62-61, Saint Joseph's last chance came when Ahmad Nivins' shot was blocked by at :02. Phil Martelli was assessed a technical foul after the play and PSU made three free throws to provide the final margin. SJU had led since the 14:27 mark of the second half, and with 5:07 to play, had a 56-46 advantage. A layup by **Rob Ferguson** put the Hawks ahead, 60-52, with 1:20 to play, but PSU would go on to score the next seven points, Nivins made one of two free throws before Morrissey hit the game-winner. SJU made 11 consecutive free throws before its first miss, and 14 of its first 15, but went cold down the stretch, missing three foul shots, including two on the front ends of oneand-one opportunities. Pat Calathes had 16 points and seven rebounds for the Hawks, with Nivins adding 15 points and eight boards. Jawan Carter notched 11 points. PSU led at halftime, 31-28, as it shot 50 percent from the field. SJU came out strong in the second half, running off the first six points, while shooting 48.5 percent in that half.

SJU 55- Boston Univ. 39: SJU's defense keyed the 55-39 win over Boston University at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse. After a sloppy first half, in which the teams combined for 30 turnovers, the Hawks used their defense to take control in the second half. SJU forced BU into 11 turnovers and a 2-for-20 shooting performance in the final 20 minutes. Trailing 26-25 at halftime, SJU scored six straight points to open the second half. The Terriers tied the score 32-32 on a 3-pointer at 12:21, but that would be BU's final field goal of the game. The Hawks then went on a 13-1 run to take command with a 45-33 lead. **Ahmad Nivins** had 12 points and **Garrett Williamson** had his first career double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds. **Darrin Govens** made his return from a fracture in his hand. to score 11 points, including a 3-for-3 effort from beyond the arc.

Drexel 72- SJU 56: SJU couldn't recover from an early 21-2 run by Drexel and fell to the Dragons, 72-56, at the Palestra in the first city game for the Hawks. Drexel took a 25-9 lead with seven minutes to play in the first half as SJU needed 13 first-half points from **Pat Calathes** to keep it close. Drexel finished a 14-3 run with 10 minutes to play to give it a 54-34 lead. DU's defense held Hawks' leading scorer **Ahmad Nivins** to just one point. Calathes had a career-high 19 points and was the only Hawk in double figures.

SJU 75- Bellarmine 63: Ahmad Nivins scored a career-high 28 points and freshman D.J. Rivera had a career-high 19 off the bench to lead Saint Joseph's to a 75-63 win over Bellarmine in the NABC Classic at Freedom Hall. SJU led from the start, but Bellarmine trimmed a 23-15 Hawk lead to 23-21. The Hawks then put together a 13-4 run to build the lead back up to 36-25. Bellarmine opened the second half with a 9-1 run to close within 41-39. A layup from Alvin Mofunanya, plus a 3-point play by Rivera and another 3-point play by Nivins quickly built SJU's lead back to 50-39 at 13:41. The Knights would not fold and closed to 60-57 with 5:40 remaining. Free throws by the Hawks increased the lead to five, but two foul shots pulled the Knights within three one more time. Nivins who was fouled as he grabbed one of his six offensive rebounds, converted both shots to give the Hawks a 64-59 edge. SJU's defense forced Bellarmine into 22 turnovers while recording a season-high 16 steals.

Louisville 74- SJU 64: Louisville led for all but the first two minutes and held a double digit lead for most of the game as the Cardinals defeated Saint Joseph's, 74-64, in the NABC Classic at Freedom Hall. **Ahmad Nivins** led the Hawks with 26 points and eight rebounds while **Pat Calathes** added 19 points and nine boards. The Cardinals led by as much as 15, but allowed the Hawks to pull within 49-44 midway through the second half. The host team went on a 14-5 run, capping it with a 3-pointer to put Louisville up 63-49.

Ohio 79- SJU 72: Ohio shot 65 percent in the second half to put away Saint Joseph's, 79-72, in the NABC Classic at Freedom Hall. Ohio led the entire game, but the Hawks closed a 12-point deficit to 54-53 with 8:14 to play, helped by two 3-pointers from **Jawan Carter**. Then trailing by only 56-55 at 7:35, the Hawks committed three consecutive turnovers that allowed the Bobcats to build their lead back to 61-55. **Rob Ferguson** hit a 3-pointer to again close within 61-58 at 5:07, but Ohio put away the Hawks with back-to-back 3-pointers giving OU a 67-60 lead with under four minutes to play. With the Hawks forced to foul, Ohio made 6-of-6 from the line in the final 30 seconds to ice the game.

SJU 55- Saint Mary's 51: Rob Ferguson scored 15 points and D.J. Rivera hit two crucial free throws in the last 11 seconds as Saint Joseph's defeated Saint Mary's at home, 55-51. Pat Calathes and Jawan Carter each had 13 points for SJU, playing without leading scorer Ahmad Nivins, who was sidelined with a sprained ankle. The Hawks started the second half with 11 unanswered points to take a 41-30 lead and led 45-36 with 11:37 left to play. SMC then went on a 13-4 spurt, and the Gaels tied the score 49-49 on a layup at the 5:11 mark. SJU moved ahead 53-49 before a Gaels layup narrowed the gap to 53-51 with 2:07 remaining. Neither team scored again, as Garrett Williamson had a key block at :04, and Rivera's two free throws accounted for the final score.

Hofstra 65- SJU 63: SJU was the victim of a last-second shot and fell to Hofstra by two points, 65-63, at the Aeropostale Holiday Festival in New York. Loren Stokes' jumper with 2.2 seconds left was the gamewinner, as the Hawks squandered 10-point leads in both halves. Hofstra trailed 48-37 with 13:17 to play but went on an 8-0 run. The Hawks still led 57-50 with 9:21 left, but they managed just one field goal the rest of the way, suddenly struggling against Hofstra's 2-3 zone defense. Jawan Carter made the second of two free throws with 31 seconds left to tie

the game at 63. Hofstra called a timeout with 23 seconds left and ran the clock down for Stokes' game-winner. **Ahmad Nivins** had 14 points in his first game back after missing one contest with an ankle injury.

SJU 58- Boston Univ. 53: Ahmad Nivins had 16 points and 11 rebounds to lead SJU over Boston University, 58-53, in the third-place game of the Aeropostale Holiday Festival at MSG. The Terriers pulled within 35-32 with 13:25 to play, but the Hawks went on an 11-0 run and BU didn't make a field goal for seven minutes, although they did get as close as five points twice. **Rob Ferguson** added 13 points for the Hawks, who finished with a 42-27 rebounding advantage and blocked seven shots. Nivins was named to the All-Tournament team.

SJU 89- Duquesne 41: Rob Ferguson scored 17 of his career-high 22 points in the first half as Saint Joseph's dominated Duquesne at home, 89-41, in the Atlantic 10 opener for both teams. Ferguson made seven of his first eight shots from the field as the Hawks stormed out to a 21-6 lead in the first 10 minutes. The junior tied his career-high in both points (22) and rebounds (8). **Ahmad Nivins** had 17 points on 6-for-7 shooting while freshman **D.J. Rivera** notched 14 points off the bench. **Pat Calathes** had 12 points, eight rebounds and tied his career high with seven assists. The 48-point margin was SJU's largest margin of victory since Jan. 24, 2004, when it won at St. Bonaventure, 114-63 (51 points).

SJU 75- Charlotte 70: Ahmad Nivins scored 12 of his 19 points in the second half as Saint Joseph's rallied to beat Charlotte, 75-70, at Halton Arena. **Pat Calathes** and **Darrin Govens** added 14 points apiece. Saint Joseph's trailed by 13 in the first half and 11 early in the second before Nivins went to work inside. He scored seven points in an 11-2 run that gave the Hawks their first lead with 5:47 left. Nivins' two free throws with

three minutes left made it 66-63 and Rivera's layup with just over two minutes left gave the Hawks a 70-65 lead. After Charlotte cut its deficit to 70-67, Calathes hit a jumper with 34 seconds left, then made two free throws with 10 seconds remaining to put the game away.

SJU 80- Temple 67: Ahmad Nivins had 20 points to lead SJU to an 80-67 win at Temple for the Hawks' ninth win over the Owls in 10 tries. **Rob Ferguson** added 17 points and seven rebounds while **Pat Calathes** scored 14 points. Temple jumped out to an early 15-6 lead, hitting six of its first nine shots. The Hawks rallied, going on a 19-4 run and taking their first lead at 20-19 on **Garrett Williamson's** layup with 8:25 remaining. The Hawks went into the lockerroom with a 40-33 lead. **Darrin Govens** and **D.J. Rivera** combined for 15 points off the bench in the half as the Hawks shot 62.5 percent from the field.

Rhode Island 86- SJU 81: Saint Joseph's fell short in its rally to overcome Rhode Island at home, 86-81, to end its four-game winning streak. The Hawks dug a hole early, trailing 46-31 at halftime and then by as much as 18 in the second half. SJU rallied, led by 17 second-half points from Ahmad Nivins, to come within single digits by the 5-minute mark. An offensive rebound and tip-in by Arvydas Lidzius pulled the Hawks to 81-77 at 1:08 and then with :50 to play, Pat Calathes scored on a layup to close the gap to 83-81. A potential tying jumper by Darrin Govens at :17 was off the mark and URI ran out the clock while hitting three of four free throws. The loss overshadowed high-scoring efforts by Nivins, who tied his career-highs with 28 points and 11 rebounds, and a personal-best 20 points and 11 rebounds from Calathes. Govens also set a new career-high with 17 points.

Fordham 56- SJU 55: The Hawks lost a defensive struggle at Fordham, 56-55, in overtime, to snap the Hawks' 12-game winning streak vs. the Rams. The Hawks fell behind early, and scored just 21 points in the first half, with Ahmad Nivins (12) and Pat Calathes (9) accounting for all of them. SJU trailed by as much as eight with five minutes to go, but went on a 7-0 run to pull within 49-48 at 2:09. With the score tied at 50-50, Rob Ferguson's potential game-winning jumper missed at :03. The teams went into overtime and D.J. Rivera rebounded a miss by Ferguson to give the Hawks a 55-54 lead. The lead was short-lived as Fordham went back down the court and scored the winning basket at :04. SJU's last chance never came about as the inbounds pass was broken up. Nivins finished with 22 points, Calathes had 13 points and Rivera scored 10 points.

SJU 82- Xavier 74: SJU battled back and held onto a late lead to defeat Xavier, 82-74 at home. **Jawan Carter** had a career-high 20 points while **Pat Calathes** (19 points), **Rob Ferguson** (16 points) and **Ahmad Nivins** (16 points) all contributed. In a close first half, Xavier's lead peaked at five, 39-34, before the Hawks cut the deficit to two, 40-38 going into the break. The teams battled back and forth early with neither side leading by more than four. With the score tied at 57, 3-pointers by Calathes and Carter gave the Hawks a 63-57 lead, one they would not relinquish, with 9:23 to go. The Musketeers came to within three on two occasions but the Hawks were able to fend off the charge to secure the victory. SJU tied its season best with nine turnovers, while shooting 59.1% in the second half.

GW 74- SJU 65: Despite a strong start and a lead it held most of the game, Saint Joseph's went cold from the field and committed key turnovers in the final minutes as George Washington rallied to win, 74-65 in Washington, D.C. GW went on an 18-3 run in the final 6:56 while the Hawks were without a field goal during that span and committed four of their 20 turnovers. The second half was close all the way through, with the teams tied seven times. After the seventh tie at 62-62, the Colonials took their first lead of the game on a layup at 3:20. GW went ahead, 68-63, and **Pat Calathes** hit two free throws to pull the Hawks within 68-65 at 1:23, but a putback gave GW a 70-65 lead at :52.

Calathes, who made six consecutive shots, finished with a career-high 21 points on 6-for-7 shooting. **Rob Ferguson** added 14 and **Ahmad Nivins** scored 12, with 10 in the second half.

SJU 84- Penn 74: Pat Calathes scored a career-high 23 points and grabbed 10 rebounds and Ahmad Nivins had 19 points and eight rebounds as Saint Joseph's defeated Penn, 84-74, at the sold-out Palestra. Rob Ferguson and Darrin Govens each had 15 points for SJU, which connected on 31 of 58 shots in the game (53.4 percent), led by Nivins, who hit 9-of-12 field goals. Penn held a 37-36 edge at the end of the first half, which saw nine lead changes with neither team gaining more than a five-point lead. Ferguson hit a 3-pointer three minutes into the second half to give the Hawks a 44-42 advantage, and they never trailed again. The Quakers rallied to within 77-72 at the 1:50 mark, but another Nivins layup and two free throws by Calathes clinched the game for the Hawks. The victory was the 234th for Phil Martelli, tying him with Hall of Famer Jack Ramsay for second most wins by a Saint Joseph's coach.

Saint Louis 73- SJU 62: Saint Joseph's couldn't hold on to its late lead and Saint Louis defeated the Hawks at home, 73-62, in the team's first nationally-televised contest. Ahmad Nivins had 14 points, Rob Ferguson had 13, and Pat Calathes posted 11 points and a career-high 13 rebounds for SJU. The game saw 18 lead changes. Saint Joseph's took a 60-58 lead on a 3-pointer by Calathes with 5:59 remaining, but the Hawks would only score two more points the rest of the way on 11 possessions. The Hawks were outscored, 40-24, in the second half, while committing seven of their 10 turnovers in that period. SLU got two quick baskets to open the second half and took its first lead, 50-49, at 10:23. SLU's largest lead of the game was the final margin.

SJU 71- Dayton 65: Pat Calathes had 20 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Hawks to a 71-65 home win over Dayton, snapping their twogame A-10 losing streak. The victory gave SJU head coach Phil Martelli his 235th career win to move him past Hall of Famer Jack Ramsay into second place on the school's all-time victory list. Ahmad Nivins had 17 points and Rob Ferguson added 15 points. Calathes also was 8-for-8 from the free throw line, extending his streak of consecutive free throws to 31. The teams went back and forth in the first half with the Hawks holding a 33-30 lead at hafltime, helped by a 56.0 shooting percentage and 11 points from Nivins. In the second half, after Dayton tied it at 38-38, the Hawks went on a 13-1 run to take their biggest lead of the game, 51-39. Jawan Carter's 3-pointer with 3:58 remaining gave the Hawks a 61-52 lead. Dayton cut the advantage to 61-57 with 2:41 left but Calathes responded with two free throws and a short baseline jump shot to give the Hawks a 65-57 lead with 1:25 remaining. Dayton got no closer than five points for the rest of the game.


Villanova 56- SJU 39: Saint Joseph's struggled in every aspect as it fell at rival Villanova, 56-39, in a nationally-televised contest. The Hawks managed just five field goals in the first half, but only trailed by nine at the break, 29-20, as Villanova had shooting woes of its own (32.4 percent). Things got worse for the Hawks in the second half as they scored a season-low 19 points on 25 percent shooting and committed a total of 21 turnovers in the game. SJU did not have any players reach double figures, but Garrett Williamson and Darrin Govens each had a teamhigh eight points. Ahmad Nivins grabbed a game-high 11 rebounds and Williamson tied his career-high with 10. It was SJU's lowest point total in 14 years.

SJU 72- La Salle 50: Saint Joseph's got off to a strong start and never looked back in defeating La Salle, 72-50, at the Palestra. **Darrin Govens** scored 15 points in his first start of the year. **Ahmad Nivins** added 14 points on his 20th birthday and **D.J. Rivera** had 13 for the Hawks, who shot 50 percent from the field. The Hawks never trailed and cruised to a 37-19 lead at halftime. The Explorers scored the first five points of the

second half to cut the deficit to 37-24, but Saint Joseph's responded with a 10-1 run to take a commanding 47-25 lead with 16:06 remaining. **Garrett Williamson** scored five points, Calathes scored three and Nivins had a basket during the spurt.

SJU 62- George Washington 56: Pat Calathes had 17 points and **Darrin Govens** scored 16 as Saint Joseph's defeated George Washington, 62-56, at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse. Calathes made his first three foul shots of the game to run his consecutive streak to 38, breaking the school record of 37 set by Delonte West in 2003-04. Calathes missed one at 5:05, which was his first miss since January 13. The game was tied nine times and saw eight lead changes, but the Hawks broke a 52-52 tie at 5:03 by scoring seven straight points, sparked by a 3-pointer from Govens at 4:35. After GW pulled within 59-56 at 2:06, **Garrett Williamson** had big defensive rebounds on consecutive Colonial possessions. Govens then hit two free throws at :57, and Calathes added the final point with a free throw at :25. Ahmad Nivins had nine points and a team-high eight rebounds, while the Hawks outdistanced GW on the boards, 35-27. Govens hit 4-of-7 from 3-point range.

SJU 76- St. Bonaventure 68: Jawan Carter scored a career-high 21 points and went 8-for-8 from the free throw line in the game's final two minutes to help Saint Joseph's seal a 76-68 win at St. Bonaventure. After shooting 13-for-25 from the field in the first half, the Hawks started the second half on a 9-0 run to open up a 42-27 lead. Still down by 15 at the 12-minute mark, St. Bonaventure went on a 16-3 run to pull within 51-49 at 7:18. But the Hawks fended off the rally with free throws from **Pat Calathes** and a 3-point play by **Ahmad Nivins** to go up 56-51 at 5:18. Carter hit consecutive jumpers to run the Hawks' lead to 64-57 with three minutes to play, and then hit all eight of his free throws in the final 41 seconds. Calathes had 18 points and 12 rebounds, **Rob Ferguson** scored 15 and **Darrin Govens** had 12 points.

SJU 92- Temple 76: SJU turned in one of its best offensive performances of the season in a surprising rout of Temple, 92-76, at The Palestra. **Pat Calathes** had a career-high 27 points and **Ahmad Nivins** had 18 points and 10 rebounds. The Hawks broke it open using a 16-0 run from the first half into the second half, while making 12 of their first 13 shots in the second. SJU eventually held a 30-point margin, but allowed Temple to score 33 points in the final 10 minutes. The Hawks shot 71.4 percent in the second half with a shooting percentage of 60.3 percent in the game. **Darrin Govens** had 11 points and **Garrett Williamson** chipped in 10 as SJU won its fourth game in a row. Calathes made a personal best 10-of-15 field goals and tied his career high with seven assists.

Richmond 78- SJU 68: SJU suffered a setback in its quest for a bye to the A-10 Tournament, losing at Richmond, 78-68. The Hawks fell behind right away due to some hot shooting by the home team, trailing by as many as 10 points. SJU whittled it down to 35-30 at the half, but Richmond started the second half with seven straight points and a 13-4 run in the first five minute to go up, 48-36. The Spiders took their biggest lead of the game, 65-44, at 7:45 before the Hawks tried to rally. A 12-1 spurt by SJU cut it to 10 points at 2:24 but it wasn't enough. Richmond shot 71.4 pecent in the second half and only had six turnovers in the game, with three of them in the final two minutes. Ahmad Nivins, who made nine of his first 10 shots, finished with 27 points and nine rebounds on 10-for-11 shooting. Pat Calathes had 20 points and nine rebounds and Jawan Carter had 13 points.

Xavier 72- SJU 62: Saint Joseph's couldn't capitalize on a fast start and fell to Xavier, 72-62, at the Cintas Center. The Hawks jumped out to an 8-0 lead, while Xavier missed its first nine shots, but then the Musketeers used a 10-1 run to take the lead. SJU led only one more time, 13-12, at 10:53, and then going cold from the field, missing five shots over seven minutes. The Hawks were down 26-22 at the half, and had 13 turnovers in the first 20 minutes. A 9-2 spurt pushed Xavier's lead to 56-42 with 6:44 to play and the Musketeers led by double digits the rest of the way. **Ahmad Nivins** had 24 points on 10-for-13 shooting and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds. **Rob Ferguson** chipped in 12 points and **D.J. Rivera** had 11 off the bench. The Hawks shot 50 percent from the field but couldn't overcome 18 turnovers. Xavier also held an advantage from the foul line, hitting 20-of-29 while the Hawks were just 9-of-16.

UMass 71- SJU 67: SJU gave a strong effort, but fell short in the end to Massachusetts, 71-67, in the regular-season finale at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse. UMass led the entire first half by shooting 64 percent, but the Hawks made their runs in the second. SJU took its biggest lead, 60-56, with under seven minutes to play and the held a 63-60 edge at 4:48. A UMass steal and ensuing 3-point play tied the game at 63-63 the Minutemen would go on to score the next four points. Trailing 70-67, the Hawks had two chances in the final seconds thanks to some miscues by UMass, but both times, SJU turned it over on the long inbounds pass attempt. Ahmad Nivins led four Hawks in double figures with 18 points, despite sitting for a 12-minute stretch with four fouls. Pat Calathes and Rob Ferguson each had 12 points while D.J. Rivera added 10. Saint Joseph's shot only 32.2 percent in the second half and committed 13 turnovers in the game.

SJU 66- Temple 62: Ahmad Nivins had 18 points and 11 rebounds and **Jawan Carter** hit two go-ahead free throws with 1:05 to play to lead Saint Joseph's to a 66-62 victory over Temple in the opening round of the Atlantic 10 Tournament in Atlantic City. Carter also hit a big 3-pointer to wake up the sixth-seeded Hawks with 3:09 to go, and **Pat Calathes** added four free throws in the final 23 seconds to beat 11th-seeded Temple for the third time this season. Calathes and Carter finished with 13 points apiece for Saint Joseph's. Temple led by as many as nine points in the second half, but Saint Joseph's took a 59-58 lead with 1:05 left, its first lead since 6-4 in the first half.

GW 58- SJU 48: George Washington forced 21 turnovers and held Saint Joseph's to a season-low 24 percent shooting from the field in a 58-48 win in the quarterfinals of the Atlantic 10 Tournament at Boardwalk Hall. **Ahmad Nivins** scored 14 of his 18 points from the foul line for Saint Joseph's, which struggled with George Washington's matchup zone. **Darrin Govens** added 10 for the Hawks, whose point total was its second lowest of the season. The turnover total was one off the team's season high. George Washington never trailed in the game, but they had to cope with a couple of Saint Joseph's spurts. The last one came when Nivins scored inside with 8:04 to play to cut the George Washington lead to 43-37. However, the Colonials scored a layup, a jumper, and a free throw to stretch the lead to 48-37.
