


2006-07: Named to the Atlantic 10 All-Conference Third Team and the All-Big 5 Second Team... Received the Robert F. O'Neill Award as the Hawks' Most Improved Player... Ranked second on team in scoring (13.9) and rebounding (7.1)... Topped the squad in assists (3.6)... Scored 16.1 points in conference games... Named the Big 5 Player of the Week for Feb. 26... The Hawks' top free-throw shooter at 84.6 percent, and set the school record with 38 consecutive made... Scored a career-hgh 27 points and added seven rebounds and seven assists in the win over Temple at The Palestra... Tallied 20 points at Richmond... Had three consecutive double-doubles, while grabbing a career-high 13 rebounds vs. Saint Louis... Scored 23 points in win over Penn, while grabbing 10 rebounds and dishing out six assists... Made his first six shots en route to a then career-best 21-point effort at GW... Notched then career-high of 20 points and 11 rebounds vs. Rhode Island for first double-double of his career... Double-figure scorer in all but seven games... Grabbed nine or more rebounds 12 times.

2005-06: Emerged as a key player down the stretch, averaging 10.7 points, 5.1 rebounds and 2.4 assists in final seven games... Had four double-figure scoring games, shot 48.2 percent (27-for-56) from the field and made 15 of 16 free throws during that span... Had a career-high 17 points at Duquesne while grabbing a personal-best eight rebounds... Matched that career high with 17 points against Hofstra in the NIT... Overall, averaged 4.8 points and 3.5 rebounds... Made the first start of his career against Kansas with a second career start at Temple... Appeared in all 33 games, seeing action at both guard spots.

2004-05: Played in 28 games, primarily as backup point guard...Tallied a career-high nine points at San Francisco... Shot 2-for-3 from the field and had six points and three assists in first collegiate game at #2 Kansas.

High School/Personal: All-State All-Central Florida First Team selection in 2004... Named the 2004 Seminole County Athletic Conference Player of the Year, and chosen to the All-County First Team... Averaged 20.5 points, 9.1 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game... Led the Lake Howell Silver Hawks to a 28-5 record and the runner-up spot in the Class 5A tournament... That team posted the best season in school history, which included a 14-game winning streak and the Seminole Athletic Conference title... Helped team reach Florida 5A Final Four as a junior, averaging 12.4 points and 5.6 rebounds... Began high school as a 5-11 point guard and encountered a tremendous growth spurt to reach 6-10 his senior year... Played at Lake Howell with his twin brother, John Jr., and younger brother, Nick, who is a freshman basketball player at the University of Florida... Marketing major... Born December 12, 1985.



2006-07: Team's third leading scorer (11.3) and rebounder (5.3)... Converted 85.7 percent from the foul line... Averaged 11.9 points per game in conference play... Posted double figures 18 times...
