The Saint Joseph's men's basketball team entered the 2009-10 season surrounded by much excitement with the return to Hawk Hill and a sparkling new homecourt - the Michael J. Hagan '85 Arena - as well as new team facilities in the Jack Ramsay Basketball Center.

What followed, though, was a disappointing season by SJU standards as the Hawks ended a string of nine consecutive winning campaigns. SJU finished 11-20 and 5-11 in the Atlantic 10, reaching the conference tournament as the 12th seed, but falling in the first round.

The season opened with a standing-room only crowd for the inaugural game in Hagan Arena against city rival Drexel. The Hawks prevailed in overtime, 77-67, as Darrin Govens hit for 23 points and Chris Prescott put his name in the books by scoring the first-ever basket in SJU's new home.

The Hawks would go on to win the next two games, including an impressive 84-80 win over Boston College at the Paradise Jam in St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. SJU was then outmatched against #7 Purdue, falling 85-60 in the tournament, before closing out play in St. Thomas with a loss to DePaul.

The Purdue loss started a six-game losing streak for the Hawks, which included defeats at Minnesota and to #3 Villanova. SJU snapped it with a win over Lehigh before the holidays but would then lose the next three, including the conference opener to rival Temple.

Saint Joseph's got back on the winning track against Fordham and despite a pair of

road losses, appeared to have turned things around. SJU beat Towson in a non-conference game and then scored a thrilling 60-59 win over eventual NIT champion Dayton at Hagan Arena. Senior Garrett Williamson had perhaps the top play of the season when he recorded a game-saving block with :04 left and the Hawks clinging to the one-point lead.

SJU rode that momentum to a win over city foe Penn for its longest winning streak of the year. The Hawks couldn't sustain the momentum and lost the next three games, including home contests to Massachusetts and Richmond. A snowstorm that pummeled the East Coast postponed the Hawks' game with St. Bonaventure by a day, but the Hawks snapped the skid with a 78-71 victory, led by 22 points from Govens and 19 from Idris Hilliard.

SJU would go on to lose the next four, including a heartbreaking overtime loss to #21 Temple, 75-67, in a Big 5 classic at The Palestra. Williamson seemed to be the hero again, as his layup with 5.7 seconds to go put the Hawks up, 59-57. But Temple's Ramon Moore went coast-to-coast before the buzzer to send the game into the extra period. The loss ruined a stellar effort from the senior duo of Govens (21 points) and Williamson (career-high 20 points).

After a rout at Charlotte, the Hawks picked up their first road win of the season, defeating George Washington, 80-71, behind double-figure efforts from Govens and Hilliard.

Owning a 4-11 record in A-10 play heading into the final regular-season game, Saint Joseph's hosted La Salle, with both teams' post-season chances on the line. On "Senior Day" SJU's seniors led the way as Williamson scored 19 points and Govens tallied 17 as the Hawks earned a 74-59 win and the 12th and final spot in the A-10 Tournament.

With a new tournament format in place, SJU had to travel to Rhode Island for the first-round game, with the winners earning the trip to Atlantic City. The Hawks trailed for most of the game, and despite pulling to within one point midway through the second half, fell to the Rams, 87-76, to end the year.

Govens, Williamson and Hilliard each finished with double-figure scoring averages, but the Hawks battled inconsistency and were without a true go-to player all season long. SJU saw glimpses of potential for the future with sophomore transfer Todd O'Brien and freshmen Justin Crosgile and Carl Jones all seeing significant playing time. The Hawks will look to build on the disappointment of 2009-10 in order to return Saint Joseph's to the Atlantic 10 prominence it has enjoyed over the years.
