

2011-12 REVIEW



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The Saint Joseph's men's basketball team entered the 2011-12 season determined to turn things around for a program which had endured two disappointing seasons. The young Hawks proved that they possessed a great deal of talent and could provide Saint Joseph's fans with much excitement.

The Hawks opened the year on the road, scoring a win over Western Kentucky, and then went 2-1 in the Charleston Classic, with victories over Georgia Tech and Tulsa. Junior **Carl Jones** displayed his scoring ability by tallying a tournament-record 38 points in the loss to Seton Hall.

SJU fans had to wait until the sixth game of the season to see the team in Hagan Arena, but they were on board immediately as SJU scored a decisive win over Penn State. Wins over Drexel and Boston University kept the Hawks on a roll on their home court, a streak that continued when they handed 17th-ranked Creighton its first loss of the season, 81-70, behind 29 points from Jones.

One of the most anticipated games in recent years occurred when the Hawks hosted rival Villanova for the first time ever on campus. Saint Joseph's students delayed the start of their semester break to provide an atmosphere not seen on Hawk Hill in nearly a decade. The Hawks, who had received votes in the Top 25, fed off the emotion and jumped out to an early lead. Although Villanova came within three points at halftime, the Hawks shot a blistering 58 percent in the second half to earn the win. **Langston Galloway** had 20 points to lead SJU in scoring, as he would 14 times during the year.

SJU ran its home winning streak to eight with a win over Coppin State and set the stage for a milestone. The Hawks' 81-50 rout of Morgan State on December 28th was the 310th victory of coach **Phil Martelli's** career, making him SJU's all-time leader in wins, surpassing the mark of 309 held by Bill Ferguson.

The last day of 2011 brought a halt to the winning streak as SJU fell to #23 Harvard on New Year's Eve. Despite an overtime win at Duquesne in the conference opener, with **Halil Kanacevic** and **Ronald Roberts** contributing double-doubles, the Hawks would struggle, going 3-5 in January.

Saint Joseph's opened February with a win at Richmond and a hard-fought victory over La Salle at The Palestra to gain a 2-1 Big 5 record. The Hawks strung together three straight A-10 wins to head into a showdown with rival Temple at Hagan Arena.

In front of a national television audience on "Senior Day," Hagan Arena was again packed to the rafters for the Owls' first visit to campus since 2001. With the City Series on the line, Saint Joseph's defeated #22 Temple, 82-72, as Galloway scored 22 points. It ended a 10-game losing streak against Temple and gave SJU a share of the Big 5 title, the 20th in school history.

The regular season ended with a double overtime loss at St. Bonaventure, but the Hawks earned the fifth seed in the conference tournament and the right to host an A-10 opening round game. Paced by 23 points from Jones, SJU defeated Charlotte, 84-60, to earn a trip to Atlantic City, and then fell to the eventual champion Bonnies in the quarterfinals, 78-71.

With a 20-13 record, Saint Joseph's received a bid to the NIT for the 10th postseason berth in Martelli's 17-year tenure. The season would end in the first round, as visiting Northern Iowa defeated the Hawks, 67-65.

During the course of the season, the Hawks put on a defensive show unlike any other in school history. **C.J. Aiken** established himself as one of the top shot blockers in the nation and the rest of the Hawks followed suit, combining to shatter the school record for team blocks with 244.

Saint Joseph's attack was balanced with four players averaging double figures, and five players earning Atlantic 10 honors, the most in school history. Aiken was named the Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Year and finished the season ranked fifth in the NCAA in blocks. Roberts showed an athleticism not seen in a long time at SJU and was named the top Sixth Man in the Atlantic 10. Galloway, who ranked fourth in the nation in three-point percentage (46.6) earned All-A-10 Second Team honors. Jones, the team's leading scorer with 17.0 ppg, received All-Conference Honorable Mention accolades as did Kanacevic, who topped Saint Joseph's in rebounding and assists.
